Joshua J. Marcuse is the founder and President of Young Professionals in Foreign Policy (YFPF), a nonpartisan, nonprofit, all-volunteer organization committed to fostering the next generation of foreign policy leaders. YFPF provides young professionals with the knowledge, skills, exposure, and relationships to tackle critical global challenges over the course of their careers. Established in 2004, YFPF is headquartered in Washington, DC, with branches in Brussels, London and New York, and has a dynamic, international membership of over 5,000 people. YFPF has hosted over 300 distinguished foreign policy leaders and experts such as White House officials, ambassadors, generals, Nobel prizewinning scholars, Pulitzer prizewinning journalists, and corporate and nonprofit leaders. YFPF also engages in public service initiatives to help refugees to resettle in America, assist returning veterans from Iraq and Afghanistan with their transition to civilian life, and educate inner-city youth about global issues.

Josh chairs the YFPF Board of Directors and manages an all-volunteer staff of over 150. He advises individuals and institutions on how to engage young professionals in the foreign policy community, and frequently speaks to recent graduates and students about careers in international affairs, leadership, management, entrepreneurship, and civic participation.

Josh is an Associate in the Mission Performance & Policy Analytics division of Booz Allen Hamilton, a management and technology consulting firm. He supports clients in the Department of Defense with the development of strategies for working with international and interagency partners to address shared national security challenges, and the integration of defense, diplomacy, and development. Previously, Josh worked as a Research Associate at the Council on Foreign Relations.

Josh serves on the Board of Advisors of Next America, a project of the Center for Strategic and International Studies, is a Truman Security Fellow of the Truman National Security Project, a Next Generation Fellow of the American Assembly, and a member of the International Institute for Strategic Studies. Josh was an Aspen Scholar at the 2009 Aspen Ideas Festival and is a member of the Aspen Socrates Society. Josh is proud to serve in the Board of Advisors of Luke's Wings, a nonprofit organization dedicated to the support of service members who have been wounded in battle and their families.

Josh graduated cum laude from Dartmouth College with honors in Government. His thesis, *The Arsenal of Democracy in the Age of Terror: Evaluating the Effectiveness of Military Assistance as a Counterterrorism Strategy*, received the Chase Peace Prize.
